What Kind of Christian Are You? Part III

The Lord Jesus Christ wants all true Christians to evaluate themselves according to His word. In 2 Corinthians 13:5 we are informed to examine ourselves to see whether we are in the faith. If you want to know what kind of Christian you are read Matthew 13:18-23. The scriptures reveal 4 kinds of Christians that receive God's word in church when the gospel of Christ is preached. When reading these scriptures, it gives you the opportunity to examine yourself to see what category you fall under as a listener for spiritual growth. Are you the kind of Christian who receives seed by the wayside, on stony places, among thorns or do you grow from God's word to be fruitful when you hear God's word? Jesus loves the church so much that He sent a letter to seven churches to warn them about sinful conduct that must be repented of before He returns for the saints of God. The prophecy to the seven churches in the Book of Revelation is a warning about how bad Christians can lose focus on what is required for repentance. Out of the seven churches only two churches were good examples of Christians in the faith that did not have to repent. That means five churches wrongfully worshipped and ministered in sin. Jesus knew there would be Christians who would come to church, live in vain, practice sin and not honor His word for righteous living. Therefore, the Lord commanded Apostle John to write the prophecy in a book, take it to the seven churches in Asia because God's judgement starts with the house of God. You can never say God didn't warn you of how to come to church

to learn, grow and worship Him to enter His kingdom. America has fallen! We are not the

Christian nation we once were. America has followed the same path as Israel with false worship

of demons, idolatry, the harlot to false gods, man's traditions, and false religion. America is

politically corrupt; the Constitution and our democracy is about to change. The church is our
