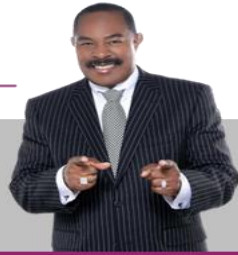

## **Pastors Wake Up – Part I**

*Commentary, June 27, 2021*

There are too many Pastors not leading the church according to the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit should be leading a Pastor to declare what Jesus Christ has spoken. I will encourage some Pastors who are overtaken by the wiles of the Devil, his trickery, deception, gimmicks, charm, and chicanery to bewitch to read John 16:13-15. The knowledge of God revealed from the scriptures points you to understand that the Holy Spirit does not speak on His own authority. Whatever the Holy Spirit hears to reveal to you as revelation knowledge, He will speak to you and tell you things to come. The Holy Spirit was sent to you to glorify Christ. HE will take what is of Christ and declare it unto you. God has given all power to Jesus Christ; therefore, the Holy Spirit will take everything Jesus has spoken and declare it to you for the divine purpose of God.

In Acts 4:10, 19-20 Apostles Peter and John proclaimed the gospel of Jesus Christ and then asked the religious rulers, elders, and scribes, “Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.” This is a great example of these Apostles, who were called by Christ to build the church, to speak what the Holy Spirit declared from Jesus Christ. Too many Pastors are not led by the Holy Spirit. I want to encourage Pastors that are not walking in the Spirit and being led by Him to stop using schemes, gimmicks, and tricks as a blueprint for your church. Turn around and serve the Lord in Spirit and in truth.

Read Matthew 17:1-6 where God corrected Peter about his desire to want to build three tabernacles. One for Jesus, one for Moses and one for Elijah, all who were called to proclaim and speak God's words as instructed, but God said that His beloved Son Jesus Christ is the voice to be heard, received, and accepted. Tabernacles are not made for men but are made as a house of worship and praise for God. Jesus Christ is to be praised, worshipped, and honored as the Savior of the world. Peter grew and learned from God that men are servants for His will and should never be regarded as equal with His Son, Jesus Christ. John 6:68-69 says, "68 But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. 69 Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Pastors wake up; preach Christ because that is the will of God for ministry.
