I don't preach a charismatic gospel according to man's ideology about faith for prosperity, and there are certain Christians who say I am not blessed, and my church is not blessed. There are ministers who view me as unlearned, unskilled and one who lacks faith in God. By the grace of God, I was called to the ministry according to Ephesians 4:11-16 to serve as a Pastor. How my congregants grow spiritually in the knowledge of God is the maturity God wants me to establish. My objective is to protect the church by not preaching a comprising gospel for gain. God has divinely given me His wisdom and knowledge to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ which is the power of God unto salvation. To all the ministers who hear me, my theology did not come from man to study their religion from their institutions. By the grace of God and the power of the Holy Spirit I have declared Jesus Christ and His gospel, and no man can take God's grace and calling from me.

Luke 4:18-19 has separated me from the traditions of men to be led by the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit to bring forth the kingdom of heaven to serve people. Having the mind of Christ never allowed me to be allured by and loyal to doctrines that build fascinations and charm to serve God. A charismatic church today is the church of Laodicea written about in Revelations 3:14-22. Ephesians 5:17 says, "Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is." Many believers are confused, broken, lost and unknowledgeable about God and His kingdom because they have been taught man's ideology

about faith. A materialistic gospel for your faith will not cause you to be changed in a moment of the twinkling of an eye when the Lord Jesus Christ comes back for the church.

As a born-again Christian, grow spiritually to position yourself not to serve God with feigned faith. It will destroy your walk with God and cause you to be left behind when Jesus returns.
