The Power of a Lie

A lie is a statement that is untrue with the intent to deceive. When a person lies, they give misinformation, misrepresentation, dishonesty, slander, and falsify things to make people believe the lie. A good example of a lie being told is in 1 Kings 13:11-29 (read the entire 13th chapter for greater context). A lying old prophet went out to meet a prophet sent by God and told him that an angel spoke to him by the word of the Lord to bring him to his house to eat bread and drink water. This was a lie and in direct contradiction to what God had already commanded of the prophet sent by Him. The lie resulted in the death of the prophet sent by God; he was killed by a lion because he disobeyed God's instructions.

When a born-again believer reads God's word it is the directive for their life to obey for righteousness. Today, many Christians listen to false doctrine, false prophesies, and false teachers that have caused them not to grow spiritually and fail God. Galatians 1:6-8 should be in the heart of every Christian to not believe a lie. Remember, false doctrine, false prophecies, and false teachers will bring spiritual death to your soul and spirit. Ministers that lie and misinform God's people are revealed according to scripture in 2 Corinthians 11:12-15. The power of a lie will destroy you if you believe it.
