Depend on the Holy Spirit and **Not Yourself – Part II**

The Holy Spirit is God's Spirit. God has given us His Spirit to overcome the Devil and the world. When we were converted from our sinful nature, we became born-again with the Spirit that created the world. Everything God says His Spirit brings it to pass because it comes from Him. The Holy Spirit is the power of God because it is His Spirit. When you say, "By the power of the Holy Spirit I am saved", you are making it known that God baptized your heart with His Spirit. As a human you have spiritual abilities for His purpose. Your spirit, soul and body are under the influence of the Holy Spirit. Your spirit can fruitfully live in the character of God by the Fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). The Holy Spirit can bring forth the power of God through you as He wills it to be. The power is the *Gifts of the Spirit* bringing forth the kingdom of heaven through you (1 Corinthians 12:1, 4-11). You are no longer a demon-led human being, full of the works of the flesh. You are now filled with the Holy Spirit to walk in the Spirit of God. John 15:26 reveals He is our Helper, which means He is our aid. He daily leads us to be holy and righteous. He furthers us in the word of God through sound doctrine to hear and understand the gospel of Jesus Christ. As our Helper, the Holy Spirit is our mentor, guide, and counselor. He corrects us when we are wrong and reminds us to testify about the name, power, majesty, and glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. If you want the kingdom of heaven to be
