

Pattern of Sound Words Stops the Devil's Deception - Part II

It is important for every born-again Christian to take the time to understand the importance of growing spiritually from the pattern of sound words according to 2 Timothy 1:13-14; and wholesome words according to 1 Timothy 6:3-5. The Devil will give you ideas to carry out his purpose. He is a spirit you do not see with demons you do not see, but they speak to your mind. The Devil wants his words to stay in your soul for you to continue to think on what he has said. He wants to control your soul, intellect, and emotions but you must grow in the knowledge and wisdom of God to not become ignorant of his devices.

My objective as a teacher is to expose the Devil and how he attacks the church. He attacks through cliché phrases and expressions of words that will trick you. Notably for Christians, the Devil uses scriptures to create his ideas to bewitch, charm and fascinate you through his wiles. The work of the Devil is to create ideas through the cliché of words by adding scripture to change God's word into a lie. The Devil is articulate, crafty, and communicative in rephrasing words. Phraseology is a word to identify how the Devil uses words through preaching styles and tones to move people to believe what he wants them to hear. God's will is to teach you His word in simplicity from the doctrine of Christ.

The doctrine of Christ moves the Holy Spirit based on what Jesus said for your salvation. Jesus Christ, the Son of God should always be exalted. The Devil will never exalt Jesus Christ. He wants to replace Him. Listen to what Luke 24:27 says, "And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself." John 16:13-15 says, "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you."

Understand how the gospel is preached and not the clichés of deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons according to 1 Timothy 4:1. Matthew 22:29 reveals there will be false teachers not knowing the scriptures nor the power of God. Luke11:52 reveals that false teachers will take away the knowledge of God. False teachers are not entering the kingdom of God, and they will cause you to not enter if you do not reject their false doctrine. Always remember the pattern of sound words stops the Devil's deception.
