

It Is Time to Be Reconciled Through Christ

While we live in this wicked, evil, divided, and immoral world there is one thing every born-again Christian can depend on...God stressing His attitude to always give His favor to bring us closer to Him. His grace is always there for His children. In 2 Corinthians 5:18-21 there is a key for every born-again Christian to believe in, “reconciliation”. God’s divine favor for us is to reconcile us back to Him as His saints through His Son Jesus Christ. Jesus was sent to save us from a condemned world and the love of God has reconciled us from sin and what was lost in the Garden of Eden from the beginning of creation. In Christ, reconciliation frees us from sin, condemnation, and the final judgement of eternal death in hell. There will be a casting into the lake of fire and brimstone preserved for the Devil, the fallen angels that followed him, and all of mankind that has rejected God. You have been reconciled to no longer commit fornication, adultery, and homosexuality with your body. When Jesus reconciled you to Himself, He gave you His love, grace, and divine call to be an ambassador for Christ until He returns. Live in the knowledge of God and be wise in your decision-making for Christ. While living in this world, remember your reconciliation to God through Jesus Christ has made you into a new creation according to 2 Corinthians 5:17. Through Christ you have been redeemed from the works of the flesh as identified in Galatians 5:19-21. Stand on the immutable word of God for you to believe and have confidence that the divine scriptures are the power for your heart and soul. Always allow your life and faith to stand in hand with God. Live unto Christ in knowledge that love, and enmity (hostility, bitterness, antipathy, grudges, and animosity) cannot cohere in church.
