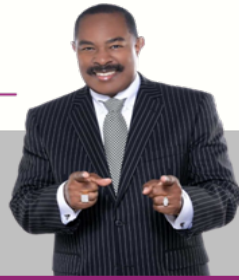

In Christ, my heart deals with my entire spiritual growth and mentality to lead and mature me for the will of God.
